Bible study

- If there is a God, then why do bad things happen to good people? Doesn't God care?

Apparent inconsistencies in the Bible

- Why did God's armies kill people and destroy other nations? What about peace, loving your enemy?
- If God is without sin, how can he "harden the heart of Pharaoh" (causing him to sin)?

Free will vs. Predestination

- Who gets to go to heaven? Is it fair?
- Is faith a choice?

Sin in the world

- Why do Christians sin? Why doesn't salvation make us perfect?
- Why do Christians use religion as an excuse for hate, sin, hypocrisy?

Covenants, sin, what does salvation look like?

- Which rules from the Bible are we supposed to follow? (What counts as sin?)
- Why is death the penalty for all sins?
- How can a single death pay for the sins of an entire world?
- Are there any second chances?
- What is the point of being good? If all sins are forgiven, then why bother; or if no matter what we do, it's not good enough, then why try?
